

### 1.25.21 OAA eBulletin – **Announcing the new February Online Show!**

Hi Everyone, it was great to see some of you at the ZOOM Annual meeting on Saturday! Hopefully, it will not be much longer before we can meet again in person.

- This bulletin is all about introducing you to the next Oakland Art Association Show, the theme of this show will be **“BLACK / WHITE and SHADES of GREY”** You may recall that this show was first proposed to include entries relative to “social injustice”, but it was decided that the two themes would show much better separately than in a combined presentation. The complete details for the show are explained in the attached rules sheet, however, here are the high points:
  - As you will guess from the title, only monochromatic artwork showing black, white and the shades of grey are eligible for this show.
  - Up to 4 entries per member – fee is \$5 per piece.
  - Deadline for entries is noon on Sunday February 28th.
  - First award \$100; Second award \$50; Third award \$25.
  - Enter by return email, with images of your art attached – include title, price, size, and medium in the email text. (Please do not use the entry forms.)

## **Exhibit Rules**

**ENTRY DEADLINE:** 12 Noon Sunday February 28th, 2021

**JUROR:** TBD

**SHOW THEME: “Black / White and Shades of Grey”:** Entries exhibited in this show must be monochromatic showing only black, white and the tones of grey in between.

## **ENTRIES:**

- **Up to 4 entries will be accepted per OAA member.**
- Entry Fee will be \$5 for each entry.
- Entries can be either two or three-dimensional work of any size.
- Entries restricted to original work – no class work or copies.
- Politically contentious or otherwise grossly inappropriate work may be rejected.
- All work must be for sale.
- Any work having won a cash award in any previous OAA show is not eligible to receive another cash award but may receive a merit award.
- If the show is oversubscribed, the Judge will reduce the entries to 55 “finalists” for awards and display in the virtual OnLine show.

## **ENTRY PROCEDURE:**

- Please email [rixingm@gmail.com](mailto:rixingm@gmail.com) before 12 Noon Sunday February 28th, 2021 with entry details and attach a digital image of each entry. Entry details must include: Medium, Title, size, and price of the unframed art.
  - Please send full sized images – bigger is better.
- Alternatively, artists may enter this show by regular USPS mail by sending all the above requirements including snapshots of their entries. Mail to: Rick Nelson / 1584 Webb Lane / Walnut Creek, CA 94595
- Entry fees for this show can be paid in two ways:
  - Online through the PayPal button on the OAA website [www.oaklandart.org](http://www.oaklandart.org). **OR**
  - With a check (made out to OAA), mailed to Rick Nelson at the address given above.
- By entering art in this show, the artist acknowledges that Association is not responsible for the appropriation of digital images from OAA websites. A “watermark” will be added to the digital entry if specifically requested.

## **AWARDS:**

- First award \$100; Second award \$50; Third award \$25.
- Merit awards are given at the discretion of the Juror.

## **SALES:**

- The member/artist retains the right to show and sell their entries at any time in other venues.
- All sales initiated through the Online Show website, will be handled by the Show Chairman.
  - The artist agrees that 30% of these sales will be taken as a donation to the OAA Educational Fund.
  - Sales tax of 9.25% will be added to all OAA sales.
- OAA policy is that no change will be made in the price (in connection with this show) after the work is accepted.

The 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Juried Art Show presented by The Piedmont Center for the Arts is a juried art exhibition selected from submissions highlighting a large variety of contemporary 2-dimensional works by Bay Area artists. Featuring original art created within the past year, 35 pieces will be selected by guest jurors **René de Guzman**, Oakland Museum of California, Senior Curator of Art, Oakland Museum of California, and **Danielle Fox**, Principal, Slate Gallery, Oakland.

Thanks to the courtesy of the John P. Thornborrow Memorial Endowment Fund, total cash awards of \$4,000 allocated to juror-designated award winners will be presented during the opening reception on Friday, April 16th.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Must reside/work within the nine counties of the Greater Bay Area Artists including: Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Solano, and Sonoma.

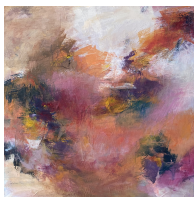
