 - Please send full sized images bigger is better.

- Entry fees for this show can be paid in two ways:

 - With a check (made out to OAA), mailed to Rick Nelson at the address given above.
- By entering art in this show, the artist acknowledges that Association is not responsible for the appropriation of digital images from OAA websites. A "watermark" will be added to the digital entry if specifically requested.

- First award \$100; Second award \$50; Third award \$25.
- Merit awards are given at the discretion of the Juror.
