ENTRIES:

Up to 4 entries will be accepted per OAA member.

- Entry Fee will be \$5 for each entry.
- Entries can be either two or three-dimensional work of any size.
- Entries restricted to original work no class work or copies.
- Politically contentious or otherwise grossly inappropriate work may be rejected.
- All work must be for sale.
- Any work having won a cash award in any previous OAA show is not eligible to receive another cash award but may receive a merit award.
- If the show is oversubscribed, the Judge will reduce the entries to 55 "finalists" for awards and display in the virtual OnLine show.

ENTRY PROCEDURE:

- Please email rixingm@gmail.com before Noon on Sunday November 29th, 2020 with entry details and attach a digital image of each entry. Entry details must include: Medium, Title, size, and price of the unframed art.
 - o Please send full sized images bigger is better.

- Entry fees for this show can be paid in two ways:
 - Online through the PayPal button on the OAA website www.oaklandart.org. OR
 - With a check (made out to OAA), mailed to Rick Nelson at the address given above.
- By entering art in this show, the artist acknowledges that Association is not responsible
 for the appropriation of digital images from OAA websites. A "watermark" will be added to the digital entry
 if specifically requested.

AWARDS:

- First award \$100; Second award \$50; Third award \$25.
- Merit awards are given at the discretion of the Juror.

SALES:

- The member/artist retains the right to show and sell their entries at any time in other venues.
- All sales initiated through the Online Show website, will be handled by the Show Chairman.
 - The artist agrees that 30% of these sales will be taken as a donation to the OAA Educational Fund.
 - Sales tax of 9.25% will be added to all OAA sales.
- OAA policy is that no change will be made in the price (in connection with this show) after the work is accepted.
